16	County exceeds the legislative power of the County in each of the following respects:						
17	a. It exceeds the legislative authority granted by ORS 203.035 in that it seeks						
18	to legislate as to matters that are beyond county concern;						
19	b. It purports to regulate matters within the incorporated cities of the County,						
20	even though none of the governing bodies of those cities has authorized						
21							
22	the application of Ordinance 2008-6 within the jurisdiction of those cities,						
23	in violation of ORS 203.040;						
24	c. It unlawfully conflicts with state statutes relating to the office of the						
25	district attorney, in violation of ORS 8.610852, and relating to the						
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1	appointment of county counsel in violation of ORS 203.145;		
2	d. It purports to alter the definition of and penalties for official misconduct		
3	under state law;		
4	e. It purports regulate building permits and land use decisions in a manner		
5	inconsistent with state law;		
6 7	f. It purports to enlarge the statutory powers of the justice court in violation		
8	of ORS 51.080 and ORS 34.020		
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11	203.065;		
12	h. It allocates money collected in fines to specific purposes, rather than to the		
13	county general fund, as required by ORS 203.065(4).

15	Ordinance 2008-6 violates the due process clause of the United States Constitution.		
16	32.		
17	Ordinance 2008-6 is preempted by the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986.

19	Ordinance 2008-6 is preempted under ORS 455.040(1).

22	Ordinance 2008-6 is preempted under ORS 701.325(5).

24	Ordinance 2008-6 is preempted by Oregon's land use planning laws.

3	1.	Declaring Ordinance 2008-6 invalid;
4	2.	Enjoining Defendants from enforcing Ordinance 2008-6;
5	3.	Awarding Interested Parties reasonable attorneys' fees and costs;
