To our ACLU of Oregon community,

Earlier this year, the ACLU of Oregon, along with ACLU National, prepared plans to resist the anti-democracy and anti-freedom attacks of a second Trump presidency. We are now ready to implement these plans.

For decades, Oregonians have been building firewalls to safeguard our communities, freedoms, and democracy. Now, with Trump threatening our most vulnerable communities, the ACLU of Oregon team is working with lawmakers, community leaders, justice organizations, and Oregonians to fortify these firewalls.

The ACLU has fought to protect and advance democracy for more than 100 years, and we are uniquely positioned to rise to the challenges of this moment — especially with our deep bench of legal, advocacy, and organizing experts, our nationwide presence, and our issue-area expertise.

At the ACLU of Oregon, we have a small but mighty team of 21 staff members. An important project we have launched is an Oregon-specific [Know Your Rights hub](#) with resources and information on multiple issues — including Immigrant and Refugee Rights, Student Rights, and more.

We have also started building a network of resistance across the state. In September, we gathered with partners and advocates from across the state during our TOGETHER Conference in order to prepare for a Trump 2.0 presidency; you can read about it on [our blog](#). And starting in January 2025, our team will be meeting with communities throughout the state about our resistance strategies for Oregon. We will share information about these events via email.

The next four years will be challenging. However, democracy takes immense effort and resolve, and the path is not always easy or smooth.

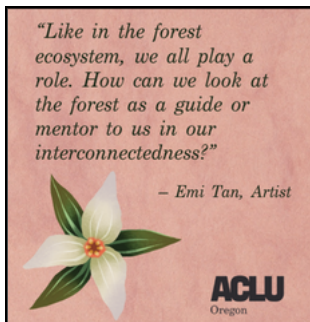
We're growing!
